Please keep it in a spot where you can refer to it when necessary.


We ask you to inform the school when your child is absent.

# STUDENT SAFETY

As parents, you play a key role in ensuring student safety around the school when you are dropping off or picking up your children. Please use the north side of the school for this.

Here are a few key points to ensure everyone has a safe arrival or departure.

- 1) Students and parents should cross at the crosswalks
- 2) If you park on the west side of the school towards the hospital, please walk down to the corner to cross. Please do not walk between the buses to get to or from your vehicle, as this is unsafe.
- Please do not park 2 or 3 deep along the road on the north side of the school. This
  makes it too dangerous for the students as they are often hidden behind
  vehicles.



# NGPS TECHNOLOGY ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE FEE

There is a \$31.50 Technology fee for students in grades one to six and \$15.75 for Kindergarten kids.

This mandatory fee enables schools to keep current hardware for our students.

### STAFF PARKING

Each of our staff members have an assigned parking stall in the parking lot west of the school. To ensure that all staff parking stalls are available to them, please park on the north side of the school.


Classroom teachers will also have given you information for joining their classroom. Please be sure to join so you don't miss out on key information.

# THINK TANK

Three years ago, our staff began to notice a decline in some student behavior. As such, we struck a committee to investigate ideas on how to proceed for this school year. Out of that work the "Think Tank" was born. In the process of our work we identified three main behaviors: Physical Aggression, Disrespect/Bullying and Disruptive/ Defiant Behavior. Students who are not meeting our behavior standards/expectations may be referred to the Think Tank. While at the Think Tank, students work on proactive measures and strategies related to a certain behavior. When the need arises, The Think Tank will be implemented during lunch recess. We saw a lot of positive gains in many students after implementing the Think Tank model.

Click "Add Student" and fill in the required fields with your child's details.


#### Why sign up for School Cash Online?

# **IN TOWN BUS FEES**



If your child is being picked up by the bus in town please be reminded that a transportation fee is required for this service. This does not apply to students that live in the Paddle Heights Trailer Park by the High School or students north of the tracks by the welding shop, but is in effect for all other students in town. The fee, set by

Northern Gateway, is \$353.00 per student, or \$177.00 for ECS. The family rate is \$883.00.
