Highlights from Board Meeting - February 13, 2024

NGPS Vision, Mission and Values - The Board began the meeting by recollecting our NGPS Vision: Northern Gateway Public Schools strives to be the place where students realize their value, discover their talents, and imagine a future where their contribution matters.

Presentation: Randy Lovich - Director of Facility Services. Randy shared with us the IMR Projects for the 2023-24 school year. (Infrastructure and Maintenance Renewal Program). The Board approved the 2023-24 IMR Plan plan as presented.
